
## Weekly Bulletin no.16 Friday 3rd February 2023

Cycling has been demonstrated to boost children's mood by raising endorphin levels, which positively impact their mental health.




On **Friday 17th February 2023**, we would like to invite someone special to your child to come into Nursery for a Valentine's theme 'Stay and Play' session.


