PRE-ORDERING SCHOOL MEALS

Log into ParentPay, click on the 'Make bookings' button to identify which days you want your child to have a meal. Save and pay it's that simple!

NHS Healthy Start Card

Get help to buy food and milk with the NHS Health Start Scheme.

What is Healthy Start?

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. We'll add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- Plain liquid cow's milk
- Fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- Fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- Infant formula milk based on cow's milk

You can also use your card to collect:

- Healthy Start vitamins these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding
- Vitamin drops for babies and young children these are suitable from birth to 4 years old
