

SPENDING MONEY

Name labelled zip up wallet with:

They will all need a small 'cross the body' wallet so they don't fall out of pockets – examples below. They must close fully with a zip. Children will also need a small backpack.







DIETARY REQUIREMENTS / MEDICAL INFORMATION

- This should have been declared on ParentPay at booking any updates please let us know. Medication that is PRESCRIBED will be collected on <u>Wednesday 5th June at 9:00am</u> by the 5 first aiders. Care plans for medical conditions will be there for parent/ carer to sign.
- Alongside first aid kits we will take stock of Calpol, paracetamol, Piriteze Antihistamine Allergy Relief Syrup for Children and children's Ibuprofen, emergency Epipen and Ventolin inhaler.
- TRAVEL SICKNESS choppy waters and long coach journeys! Please supply these NAME LABELLED and hand in at drop off on night of departure having administered a tablet at 9:30pm by parent/ carer – MRS ELLIOTT

Dosage: Tablets may be sucked, chewed or swallowed up to 30 minutes before travelling to prevent travel sickness, or at the onset of nausea.

If your child is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance payments. We can apply for a priority pass, no earlier than one month before our visit. A priority pass enables your child plus 4 others priority access onto rides and attractions decreasing the wait time.

In order for us to be able to do this we will need an electronic passport style photograph of your child to attach to the application and original documents stating that your child is entitled to/ in receipt of Disability Living allowance. This original document then needs to be taken with us to Paris and shown as proof to collect the priority pass when we arrive at Disney.



Wristbands – children will wear an emergency contact wristband for the duration of the visit for safety.

Mobiles/ Electronic devices – children must not bring these <u>except</u> the children who have Type 1 Diabetes as their phones link to their pumps. They will need chargers and a Euro adapter for the sockets.
