## **School Updates and New Class Structure**

Dear Parents and Carers,

As the term comes to an end, the children and staff are still working exceptionally hard learning together. It really is a joy to lead a school like ours – the sense of pride I feel is immense. The last 18 months have been some of the strangest but every day our young people have amazed us. I am thankful for all of you – parents, carers, families – you have championed our school and partly because of this, the school has doubled in size since I took over as Headteacher. We have welcomed so many new children over the last year and for the first time we had appeals for school places and a waiting list in reception! We have gone over the PAN (Pupil Admission Number) this year and offered places to all of the children on the waiting list.

Ready for a new school year, I am sure you will be pleased to hear that staff have carefully put together class lists for September based on the children's learning and developmental needs. Playtimes and lunchtimes are a time to meet up with friends from other classes and socialise. The last day with their current class is **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> July**. This year the children will start in their new classes on **Monday 19<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July**. This will allow them to become familiar with their new classroom and teaching team. Please note - school finishes at normal time and there will be Homehub as normal on the Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> July. There will be more details about dropping off and collecting sent soon.

IMPORTANT: If your child is in Caterpillars and is moving to Reception they will spend their normal sessions in their new classes also; for example if they usually attend in a morning they still come in 8:30-11:30am, if they normally do all day, they attend 8:30am-3:15pm or if they normally do an afternoon, they attend 12:15-3:15pm.

School reopens on **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> September**. The school day is attached and so is the uniform expectation leaflet. Please note **black school shoes** not trainers are to be worn. The uniform is all in stock and can be ordered via this link:
