## Leap years!

4 million people in the world are leap day babies. Leap day babies are called leapers or leap lings. There is a one in 1,461 chance of being a leap day baby.
A leap year is a year in which an extra day is added to the Gregorian calendar, which is used by most of the world. While an ordinary year has 365 days, a leap year has 366 days.
We have leap years because instead of 365 days, the Earth really takes a few minutes less than 365-1/4 days (365.24219) to go completely orbit the Sun.
Without leap years, the seasons would start one day earlier on the calendar every four years.
