Log into ParentPay, click on the '**Make bookings'** button to identify which days you want your child to have a meal. Save and pay it's that simple! If you do not pre-order your child a meal, they will not be able to order one in school and so you will need to provide them with a packed lunch from home instead. You will not be able to order a meal if you have an outstanding balance on your account. This will need to be cleared in full before you can order further meals.

# NHS Healthy Start Card



Get help to buy food and milk with the NHS Health Start Scheme.

#### What is Healthy Start?

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. We'll add your benefit onto this card every 4 weeks.

#### You can use your card to buy:

- Plain liquid cow's milk
- Fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- Fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- Infant formula milk based on cow's milk

#### You can also use your card to collect:

- Healthy Start vitamins these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding
- Vitamin drops for babies and young children these are suitable from birth to 4 years old
