 Achieved the 'Gold' School Games Mark We have a wide range of sports coaches into school boosting the children's engagement and enjoyment of sport. We have entered and competed in over 15 different sporting competitions in the local area – allowing children of all abilities and competences to experience competition and varied sporting events. We have massively expanded the amount of resources and equipment available for all year groups. Children have been able to access a variety of sports and use new equipment. We have had visits from Olympians and Female Superleague Footballers – this has inspired many young children to get into sport and become a little more active.
