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YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL VISIT TO LLANDUDNO

Please find below final details about our residential visit to Llandudno.

We will be leaving school on **Tuesday 3rd June at 8:30am** so children will need to arrive promptly on this date. They will return to school on **Wednesday 4th June at approximately 6:00pm**, however we will update you via text message and Class Dojo if there are any delays. Your child must be collected by an adult from the Key Stage Two big yard.

If your child requires any medication during the residential, then a medical consent form must be completed and handed to the designated first aider – Mr Dunning - on the morning of the visit, along with the medication needed. All medication must be clearly labelled. This includes any travel sickness medication which may need to be taken for the return journey. Any travel sickness medication required on Monday morning should be given by parents or carers before arriving at school. Mr Dunning will be on the Key Stage Two playground, along with class teachers, just before 8:30am on the Thursday morning. If you require a medical consent form, please collect this from the Key Stage Two Office before the visit.

On Tuesday 3rd June, the children will need to wear their full Forest School kit or, if the weather is warm, PE shorts or skorts, with their Forest Schools top.

Kit List

Your child will need:

- To be wearing their **Forest Schools** kit for Tuesday (includes t-shirt and hoodie).
- Fresh set of clothing for Wednesday. This should include:
Underwear and socks
T-shirt/top
Joggers, tracksuit bottoms, leggings or shorts (you may wish to send both shorts and longer bottomed trousers in case of a change in weather whilst away).
- No skirts, vest tops, cropped tops or dresses please.

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In addition to the above, children will also need:

- A waterproof coat
- Suitable outdoor footwear for walking such as comfortable trainers or walking boots. No sandals are to be worn.
- Pyjamas and slippers/indoor shoes
- Toothbrush, toothpaste, towel, and hairbrush
- Suncream (labelled with your child's name)
- Book to read (optional)
- Sun hat
- Labelled water bottle as these can be filled up throughout the visit.
- As explained above, any medication will need to be sent with a medical form, this includes any travel sickness medication for the journey home.
- No more than **£30** to spend – this will be your child's responsibility and must be in a name-labelled purse or wallet.
- **STRICTLY NO MOBILE PHONES or HANDHELD DEVICES** are to be brought from home. Teachers will have mobile phones with them in case of an emergency.

Please remember to label all items clearly.

Activity programme

Confirmed activities for the duration of the residential include:

- A visit to the Welsh Mountain Zoo
- Visit to the arcades
- Tram journey and visit to the Great Orme, including a visit to the Gold Mines
- Two treats - ice cream and chips.
