They will discover the Spanish culture, the language and even have a go at flamenco dancing.




We ask that the children come to school dressed in the colours of the Spanish flag (red and yellow).

After School Decompress

Following the school day many children will be burnt out from sensory overload, social exhaustion and supression.

Here are some tips to support decompression and limit after school meltdowns:

- Avoid immediate demands; unpacking bags and getting changed can wait.
- Avoid asking about their day (unless they offer it), allow time and space to process it.
- Provide a consistent and predictable after school routine.
- Give them a substantial snack.
- Prepare them for any changes to the norm i.e. Childminder is collecting them.
- Respect alone time if they seek it.
- Allow jumping and loud time if needed.
- Allow plenty of time with a special interest.



An appeal to all parents and carers of children who are using mobile phones, tablets, games consoles or other devices.

Please, please check what they are doing every day - read messages, listen in, make it your business to know what your child is doing, and protect them. We have some children participating in group chats and online chats that aren't very nice and are really unkind.

School are not responsible for supervising children's personal technology and are having complaints from parents about some children.

School staff are limited what they can do as this is not happening in our care. It is the responsibility of the parents and carers to 'police' this. It's happening at home. Take phones off your children, restrict their usage, monitor their usage daily, talk to your children about the implications of bullying online etc. Report harmful material, online bullying or malicious communications to the police.

Ask yourself ... Why does my primary age child need a phone? Give them back their childhood and take control of their screen time.

I read this the other day and it rang true ... "Mobile phones are stealing children's childhoods. They're being pulled into the online world before they've had the chance to live in the real one."

Thank you Sarah Tomlinson Important Information Regarding Holidays

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Government discourages the taking of holidays in term time. Evidence shows that children who miss school do not achieve as well as those who attend regularly.

As of September 2013, the law restricted a Headteacher's ability to authorise holidays during term time, Headteachers are now only empowered to approve a leave of absence when it is requested in advance by the parent or carer with whom the child resides, and when circumstances of the requested leave are 'exceptional'.

A new National Framework for Penalty Notices for School Absence will come into effect from the 19th August 2024. Should you choose to take a holiday for 5 consecutive school days or more during term time the Local Authority will be informed as this will constitute an unauthorised absence. A Fixed Penalty Notice will then be issued in accordance with Section 444 of the Education Act 1996.

The law stipulates that the current penalties payable by parents/carers are £80 when the penalty is paid within 21 days, and £160 when the penalty is paid within 28 days. This penalty is per parent/carer, per child. If the fixed penalty is not paid this could lead to you being prosecuted in the Magistrates' Court.

Where it is deemed appropriate to issue a second penalty notice to the same parent for the same pupil within 3 years of the first notice, the second notice is charged at a flat rate of £160 if paid within 28 days.

In cases where there have been 10 sessions of unauthorised absence within a 3 year period of the date of the first absence and if there is a 3rd occasion of unauthorised absence (10 sessions), alternative action will be taken instead. This will often include considering prosecution, but may include other tools such as one of the other attendance legal interventions.


