PART ONE

The order of the agenda was altered slightly so that Ms Williams, the DHT could complete a presentation about the Pupil Premium update.

Ms Williams outlined what Pupil Premium is and how children qualify for this additional amount of money. The purpose of the award is to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and nationally this is 14%, at Darnhall as of January 2018, this stands at 45% of the pupils on roll with a pupil premium award this year of £161,040.

Areas where this is spent include Family Support which supports 45 children. Teaching Assistant support in classes and additional class teachers to ensure small class sizes.

On the School website the school must show the pupil premium spend, with a breakdown given to Governors and the impact this has had for the pupils. Data analysis has been completed and shared with Staff which shows the areas for development.

Ms Williams highlighted the 'Achievement for All' programme which is fully funded by the LAWEP and involves a 'coach' working with the school to help them close the gap between disadvantaged pupils in addition to children with SEND needs and all other pupils. This will also involve better engagement with parents of disadvantaged children which will raise aspirations across the whole of the Winsford cluster schools.

Governors gave thanks for the presentation which demonstrates really good data and the best ever analysis.

Q; is the school website now up to date with this information?
A; Ms Williams advised that the spend details will need to be added as soon as possible.

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ACTION;

Headteacher highlighted that now the school has an effective Pupil Premium Lead, she believes they should attend the CWAC Finance Meetings. The Vice Chair agreed with this suggestion.

Mr Woods took the position of Chair as apologises had been received for Mr Strachan.

10. FINANCE

Grants/funding and potential projects

Mr Burrows reported that he is looking to apply for a grant for up to £10k per year from the BBC Children in Need as they award grants each year to organisations supporting disadvantaged children and young people in the UK.

He will be working with Charlotte Chappell; the new Resource Provision Leader and the grant will be sourced for use in the Resource Provision Unit and maybe to look at getting a mini bus for the school.

Q; when does the application need to be completed by?

A; this will need to be done by mid-May.

Q; whilst acknowledging the importance of the Resource Provision unit, is this the best area to be asking for funding for? What about more ELSA trained Staff? A; Headteacher acknowledged this point but believes a strong application will be made by the people involved and is hoping it is successful. She will speak to the SLT after half term and will feedback any important points.

Mr Burrows also advised that if this application is not successful, another one could be made later in the year.

Headteacher advised that the Stonewall policy has been emailed to all Governors for consideration. The way this will be dealt with at the school is there may be many different

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family units but there is one love overall and the children are very accepting of different circumstances in different families. The school will also be teaching how a healthy parental relationship is important.
